



## ARE YOU SUITABLE FOR PERMANENT MAKEUP?

**You are NOT a suitable candidate for PMU if any of these applies to you:**

- Pregnant or nursing
- Anyone under the age of 18 years old
- Heart conditions, uncontrolled High blood Pressure, Poor general health.
- Chemotherapy patients need to wait 6 months after last treatment or consult their doctor
- History of Keloids or Hypertrophic scarring (if you develop keloid scars easily. you are not considered a good candidate for permanent makeup)
- Individuals with Mitral valve or Prolapse valve or other Heart problems need to get a doctor's note prior to appointment
- Individuals with certain autoimmune disease will be unable to have the procedure
- Diabetics (require doctor's clearance prior to appointment)
- Viral infections and/or diseases
- Epilepsy
- Pacemaker or major heart problems
- Organ transplant
- Skin irritations or Psoriasis near the treated area (rashes, sunburn, acne, etc.)
- Sick (cold, flu, etc.). Must wait a few days until symptoms are gone.
- Clients on antibiotics may be turned away depending on the reason they take their medication (WAIT 7 days after you are off antibiotics to schedule appointment)
- You may be turned away as result of other possible health concerns, feel free to email me and we can discuss if there is an issue. When in doubt ask your doctor
- Any treatment, medication, or illness that compromises the immune system/ healing would make you NOT a good candidate for micro pigmentation procedures
- Botox (must wait 3 weeks following botox if in brow area)
